

# *AN INVITATION TO*

## **A&ASP [Inc] PONY CLUB HI-POINT AWARDS**

The purpose of these Awards is to recognise the achievements of Pony Club members riding Appaloosas or Australian Spotted Ponies.

### CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY IN THE HI-POINTS AWARDS:

#### A. REGISTRATION

1. All registered A&ASP [Inc] Appaloosas and ASP's are eligible.
2. Animals Registered with AAA and APPA that meet A&ASP [Inc] standards are eligible to be registered with A&ASP [Inc]. They are then eligible to enter this competition.
3. If an unregistered Appaloosa or Australian Spotted Pony [mare or gelding] has sufficient colour and characteristics it may be eligible for PERFORMANCE ONLY registration with A&ASP. The horse or pony would then be eligible to enter this competition.

#### B. MEMBERSHIP

1. A&ASP JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP [25 and under]: \$30, plus \$15 joining fee

Junior members are eligible to compete in these special A&ASP [Inc] PONY CLUB HI-POINT awards and in all other A&ASP [Inc] awards and competitions, including State and Branch Shows. Junior members receive a copy of the Rules Book, Society Badge and four annual copies of the Society's magazine "On The Spot".

#### OTHER CONDITIONS

- 1 The entrant **MUST** be a member of a Pony Club.
- 2 Each entry is for one Appaloosa/Rider or one ASP/Rider combination only.  
Score Sheet to be signed by a recognised official on the day, e.g. an instructor, judge at show, steward etc.
- 3 Time Frame: the competition runs from *30/6/08* to *30/6/09*

NOTE 1: Awards secretary shall adjudicate on points and section divisions.

NOTE 2: The whole event must be completed to obtain points. Where an event is made up of more than one section (eg. Horse Trials), only the whole event is eligible for points.

NOTE 3: Only half points awarded when less than 6 in competition.  
(As in an amendment made to the rules & regulations in 1996/97).
